## 1933 STATE BOYS' TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIP

Dudley Stadium - Nashville, TN May 13, 1933

Knoxville high, putting two firsts, seven seconds, one third and a fourth together captured the Vanderbilt invitation meet for state high schools yesterday at the Vandy stadium. The Knox county cinder brigade collected 34 points for first place bonors, but the meet was in doubt until after the final event was run. Johnson City finished second with 28% points.

There were a total of 15 schools to score in the meet with the other teams finishing with the following scores: Morristown 23. Oliver Springs 10, Memphis Central 10, Nashville Central 7, Messick 7, Hume-Fogg 7, East 6, Germantown 4, Decaturville 3, Montcrey 1, Collierville 1, Millington 1, and Hay Long 1-2.

Clark of Morristown finished first in the individual scoring with 12 points which were gained by firsts in the shot put and invelin throw and a third in the discusting. Cross, who idid all the Oliver Springs scoring, was second with 10 which illustrated firsts in the 100-yard dash and 220-yard dash.

Excellent times were chalked up in the half mile and mile events. Overholt of Morristown \*tepped off the half mile in two minutes, 2.5 seconds which the followers of high school track meets believed cut a second off the old record. In the mile Word won in 4 minutes, 44.1 seconds which was believed to have cut three seconds off the old mark.
