BOYS RESULTS – FINAL ROUND

University School of Jackson Wins A-AA Golf Championship; Bradley Pate of University School of Jackson Captures Individual Title

MURFREESBORO - -University School of Jackson won the 2002 Class A-AA Golf Championship and were led by Bradley Pate, who shot a 138 (72-66) to win the individual title. Pate, a senior, was two strokes behind Smith County's Greyson Painter, heading into the final day of competition. Pate's score of 66 is tied for the fourth best 18-hole individual score at the state tournament. His two-day score of 138 is also tied for the fourth best 36-hole individual score.

Pate combined with teammates Robert Lents 144 (71-73), Parks Williamson who shot a 149 (73-76), Luke Ferguson who shot a 159 (77-82), and James Morgan who shot a 165 (82-83) to give USJ two-day team score of 590, which is tied for the third best 36-hole team score in state tournament history.

Christian Academy of Knoxville's Matthew Mincer and Smith County's Brent Long finished tied for runner-up with a score of 141. Mincer, a senior, also finished tied for runner-up last year.

Jonathan Mount of Kingston shot a 143 (72-71) to finish in fourth place. Greyson Painter of Smith County, University School of Jackson's Robert Lents, and Wes Williams of Christ Presbyterian Academy each finished with a 144 and tied for fifth. Williams score of 144 helped lead CPA to a team runner-up finish.

Smith County's Greyson Painter Leads by One Stroke After Day One; University School of Jackson Leads by Nine Strokes

MURFREESBORO - - - Greyson Painter shot a 36 on the front nine and a 34 on the back nine to give him a one-stroke lead after the first day of competition at Old Fort Golf Course. University School of Jackson's Robert Lents, Anderson County's Jon Fox, and Wes Williams of Christ Presbyterian Academy each shot a one-under 71 to finish one stroke behind Painter heading into the final day. The four will be the last boys group to tee off the number ten tee at 10:30 a.m.

Robert Lents combined with Bradley Pate's 72, Parks Williamson's 73, and Luke Ferguson's 77 to give University School of Jackson a team score of 293 and a nine-stroke lead over Christ Presbyterian Academy.

Wes Williams led CPA with his 71 and combined with teammates Clark Brewer, Robb Williams, and Campbell Brewer who shot 76, 76, and 79, respectively. Kingston finished day one with a team score of 307 to finish five strokes behind CPA and 14 behind USJ for the lead.

Bradley Pate of University School of Jackson, Mitch Brock of Marshall County, Jonathan Mount of Kingston, and Brent Long of Smith County each shot 72 to finish tied for fifth place, just two strokes off the lead.

Parks Williamson of University School of Jackson and Matthew Mincer of Christian Academy of Knoxville each shot a 73 to finish the first day tied for ninth.

Eighteen individuals had a score of 75 or better. Thirty-three players finished with a score below 80.
