**CLEVELAND** -- Farragut scored four runs in the first inning and never looked back in its 12-4 victory over Houston Friday to advance to the TSSAA Class AAA Baseball championship game at Historic Engel Stadium later Friday.

Jason Wright drove in the first two runs with a single. Chris Goodrich and Davis Burklin also had RBI singles in the frame.

Wright would finish 2-for-4 with a home run and drove in three runs. Burklin was 2-for-3 with 2 RBI and a double. Steven Curtis scored three times, drove in two runs and had a double for the Admirals (34-9).

Houston's highlight was back-to-back homers in the sixth by Josh Mungle and Erik Filsinger, which cut the score to 10-4.

Farragut touched home twice in the seventh to ice the victory.

Jay Sadlowe picked up the victory for Farragut. He pitched 5-1/3 innings, allowed six hits, four runs, three earned, walked two and struck out four.

The Mustangs end their season with a 33-11 record.
