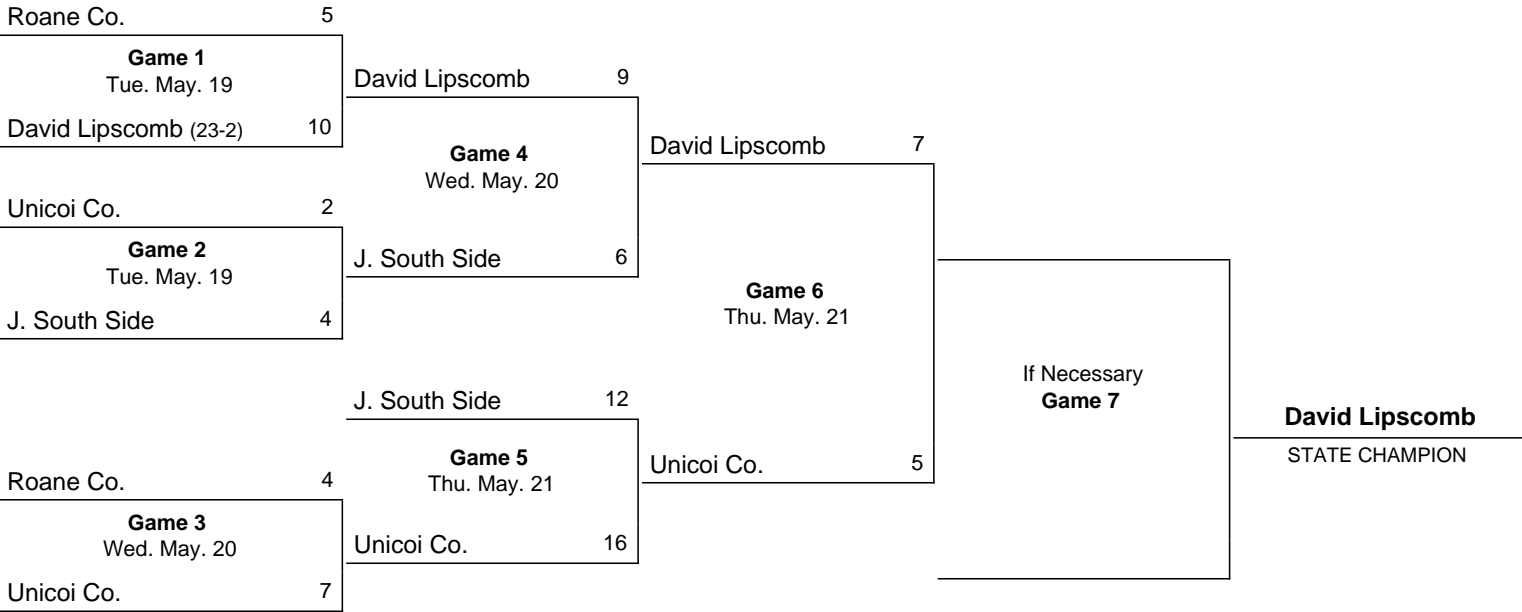

TULLAHOMA, Tenn. – Unicoi County scored five runs in the first inning and held off Kingston 7-4 in an elimination game in the TSSAA Class AA Baseball Tournament at Motlow State Community College on Wednesday.

Josh Bailey hit a three-run home run as part of the five-run first for Unicoi County. Jonathon Johnson scattered seven hits and struck out eight to pick up the complete game victory. Johnson also worked out of a bases loaded jam in the last inning.

Bryan Crouse had a solo home run in the third inning for Kingston and drove in two runs on three hits. Unicoi County (28-5) will play the loser of Wednesday's David Lipscomb-Jackson South Side game on Thursday at 12:30 p.m. at Motlow State.

Roane County ends its season with a 29-2 record.

Roane County (29-1) jumped out to a 5-1 lead after the top of the second inning.

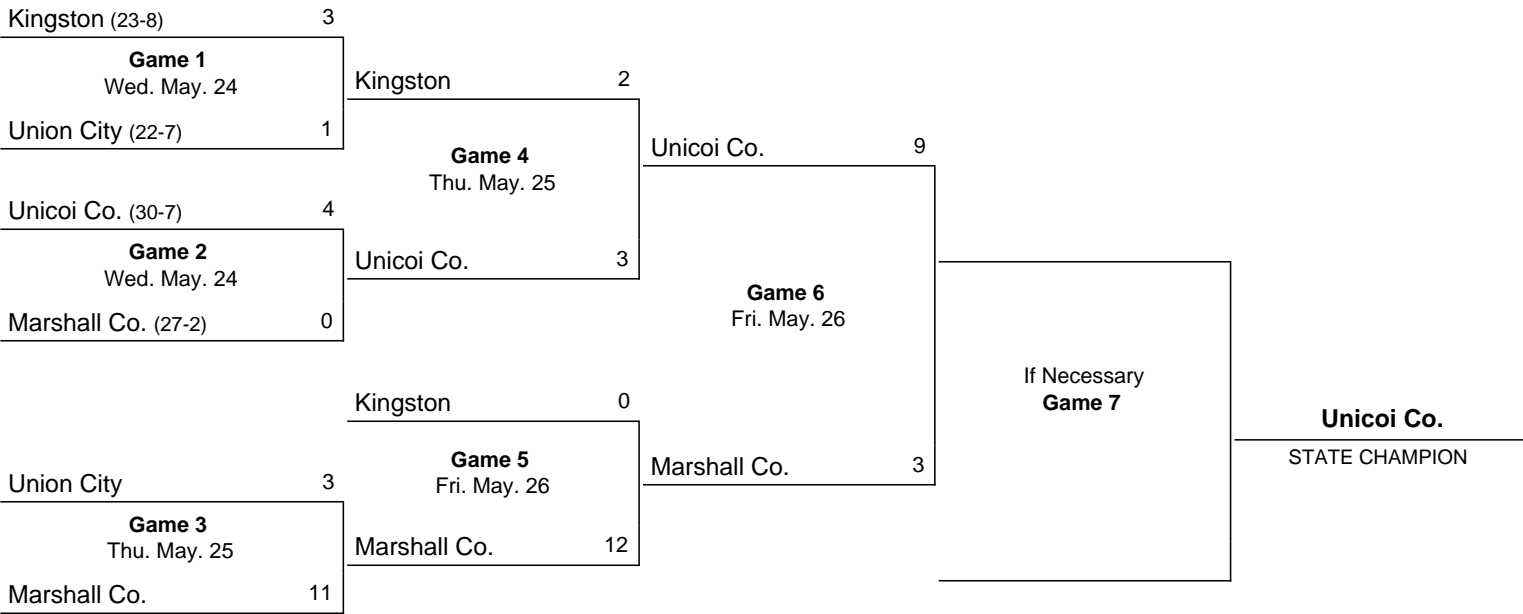
Ryan King had three hits and Brady Collins had a pair for the Yellow Jackets.

ECS defeats Roane, 12-8

MURFREESBORO — Evangelical Christian School is one game away from a perfect season after beating Roane County 12-8 last night in the Class AA semifinals of the TSSAA state baseball tournament being played at Middle Tennessee State.

The Eagles, from Cordova, Tenn., are 29-0 heading into tonight's championship series, which will follow the the 5 p.m. Class A final.

Roane County of East Tennessee dropped into the loser's bracket semifinal against Marshall County, a 5-3 winner over McMinn County earlier yesterday.

The Marshall County-Roane County game, a rematch of the first

round of the tournament, which Roane County won 13-10, will be played today at noon with the winner earning a finals berth.

Roane County's record dropped to 26-4.

Roane County threatened in the seventh inning last night, scoring five runs after taking advantage of three ECS errors.
