

CHATTANOOGA -- Chattanooga Central's Josh Scott scattered four hits in posting a 8-0 victory over Carter in the first round of the TSSAA Class AA Baseball Tournament played at Engel Stadium.

Scott also drove the first run of the game with an RBI single to center to plate Eric Oliver, who led off the inning with a walk. He pitched the complete game, striking out five and walking two.

Central plated runs in each of the first four innings. The big blow in the three-run third inning was a two-run triple by Andy Nelson.

Rocky Evans was 2-for-3 with an RBI for Central.

Carter's Brent Hoskins took the loss. He allowed eight runs, six earned, scattered eight hits, walked four and struck out three.

CLEVELAND -- Marshall County took advantage of Chattanooga Central walking eight batters to advance Wednesday to the TSSAA Class AA Baseball Tournament championship game later Wednesday.

Tyler Tillman picked up the victory for the Tigers, scattering six hits, allowing one run (in the first inning), walking one and striking out six. He threw just 73 pitches.

Central (33-6) took a 1-0 lead in the first inning on Rocky Evans' run-scoring single.

Marshall County (31-3) would tie the game in the second on Ryan Derryberry's RBI-single.

Central answered with a pair in the bottom of the fourth as Josh Scott scored on a fielding error and Josh Edmondson drove in a run with a sacrifice fly.




KNOXVILLE faces Memphis Kingsbury today for the title.

The losing pitcher was Freddle Dukes. Chattanooga finished the season with an 18-3 record while Knoxville now is 22-2.

KINGSPORT — (\mathcal{P}) — Bob Baskette's tie-breaking single in the last of the ninth with two outs and the bases loaded gave Chattanooga Central high school a 3 to 2 victory over Memphis Treadwell last night for the TSSAA baseball championship of 1955.

Central, finalist in the winner's bracket with two straight wins, took a 2-0 lead in the fifth inning when Royce Powell slammed an inside-the-park homer with Earl Ziegler on base.

Treadwell rebounded in the top of the sixth to tie it up at 2-2 on singles by Jimmy Martin, Ted Steele and Harold Daniel. From the sixth inning on, each team left runners stranded in every frame except the seventh, when Treadwell went down in order.
